### DETAILS

This project was completed for the Western Education and Library Board at Omagh High school, Crevenagh road, Omagh.

The project involved the construction of a multi purpose pitch surface including extensive earthworks, drainage, fencing and electrical package. The project was carried out during summer months to minimise disruption to the school and local clubs who avail of the facilities.

A 3G pitch surface was laid including a synthetic grass laid on to a shock pad carpet. Sand was dispersed on top of the synthetic grass and brushed into the surface; this is renewed annually to replenish it.

### HEALTH AND SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

On the completion of this project we produced a Health and safety file containing all relevant information on how to maintain and care for the pitch and details of health and safety precautions which should be taken while doing so.

### ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

The Drumragh River flows adjacent to the site and special care had to be taken to prevent any pollution of the river or surrounding areas. Sustainable drainage was installed throughout the site and settlement ponds were installed to remove suspended solids from the outflow.
